The natural beauties of the Madeira island were not excluded from the activities nor its culture, traditions or flavors. The Ethnographic Museum of Madeira led the group on a journey through time to Madeiran habits and customs; the Casa do Povo da Ribeira Brava Folk Group introduced our sounds, rhythms and history, in a lively folklore exhibition.

During these 4 days, memories, affective bonds and complicities were created, knowledge and visions of the world, of education and of the reality of schools were shared, contacts opened up possibilities and privileged ways of cooperation.
